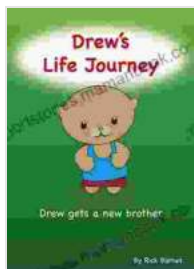

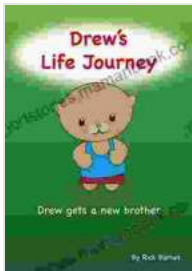
The Special Bond Between Siblings
