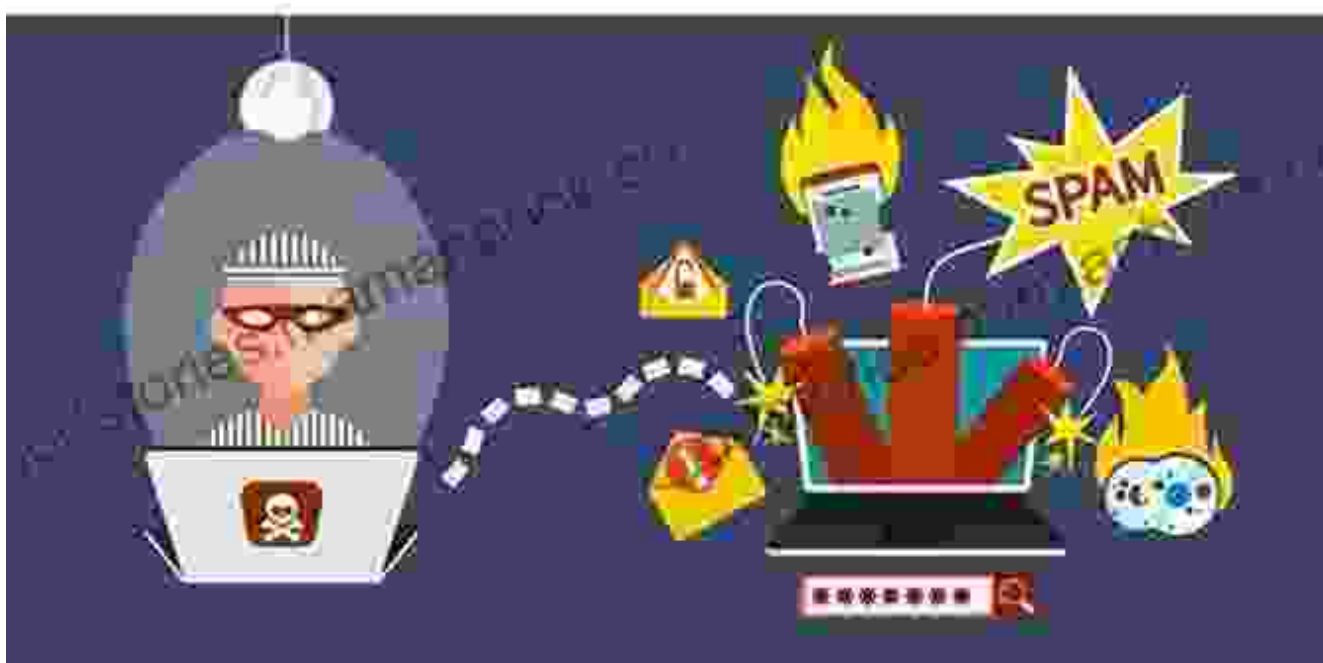


4. Malware Scams
